

Central Otago Project: Community Drop-ins

Kia ora koutou,

Over the last two years, our mahi has focussed on growing our understanding of the region, the proposed site environment – including weather, water, landscape, land transport, and ecology, and undertaking more detailed aeronautical analysis, including flight paths and determining a preferred runway alignment.

This will lay the groundwork for good decision making based on high quality information and sound understanding of the region, site features and impacts.

Over that period, we have been asked a wide range of questions and are now in a position where we can share further information about what we have learnt. We hope this goes some way to answering those questions.

As part of sharing this information, we will be holding community drop-in days in Tarras, Cromwell and Wānaka. Like our previous drop-in days, you'll be able to engage with the information, and we'll be on-hand to answer questions and talk with you about the project.
